<b>Skills targeted General learning objectives</b>	<p>The aim of the internship is to strengthen students' professional skills and develop their way of working so as to meet professional requirements.</p> <p>During the internship, students will get a taste of the following aspects:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• collaboration with people from inside and outside the company</li> <li>• innovation and product design (MADP) - innovation and formal research (MATD) - innovation and visual and technological research (MAP)</li> <li>• object-oriented development (MADP) - graphics development (MATD) - development of photography skills (MAP)</li> <li>• project management</li> <li>• marketing and customer relations</li> <li>• value creation, resource management and project presentation.</li> </ul>
<b>Teaching content and form</b>	<p>The internship, which is optional, must be approved by the head of department and organized within the required timeframe - to do so, please refer to the "Internship guidelines". The internship is optional and replaces the ECAL-HEAD common modules and the modules that are common to all ECAL courses in S3.</p> <p>The student makes the necessary arrangements with the host company and prepares all relevant documents. If necessary, he/she can be advised by the head of department. The company concerned is active in the design field and there must be a connection to the student's chosen specialisation. The internship must be overseen by a professional in the field - the internship supervisor.</p> <p>Before the internship begins, an internship agreement is signed by ECAL, the host company and the student. Among other things, the agreement defines the terms and conditions and the main objectives of the internship.</p>
<b>Forms of assessment and validation</b>	<p>A final review of the internship is compulsory. It should be scheduled shortly before or after the internship ends and should be attended by the head of department, the internship supervisor and the student.</p> <p>The internship evaluation is carried out by the head of department. It is based on reports written by the student (self-assessment report) and the internship supervisor (evaluation report), as well as on the final review.</p> <p>If the internship is validated, the student is awarded 15 ECTS credits.</p>
<b>Remedial teaching</b>	<p>Remediation is not available.</p> <p>If the internship is not validated, the student will not receive any ECTS credits. However, he/she may continue with the second year of the master's course, provided he/she takes all of the modules on the curriculum for S3.</p>
