<b>Skills targeted General learning objectives</b>	Several workshops are offered to the students of all the majors of the Master HES-SO in Design, in order to allow them to share their experiences in the field of creation and innovation, and to develop competences in different fields.
<b>Teaching content and form</b>	The workshops take place at ECAL and HEAD - Geneva during the fall semester. Their respective dates are set according to the agenda of each major. The programs are communicated at the beginning of the semester.
<b>Forms of assessment and validation</b>	The project carried out is subject to evaluation by a college of teachers at the end of the workshop. The student must achieve a minimum grade of 4 to obtain credits.
<b>Remedial teaching</b>	Remedial teaching is possible in case of slightly insufficient results (3,5 grade), under the conditions agreed with the head of the module. The module must be repeated in the academic year following a fail mark, according to procedures to be agreed with the head of the module. No remediation is possible after repeating the module.
